This camp is open to elementary-aged children in kindergarten to fifth grade and to junior leaders in middle school or high school. We are inviting children from our church as well as our neighborhood programs. This will be a great way to make new friends and connect with friends you already know. The theme of this camp is “Honoring the Earth.” We will be celebrating the earth through science, art, nature exploration, drama, and more! We will wrap up our camp with a Spring Pageant on Saturday, March 20, with a potluck dinner and worship service celebrating the arrival of spring.

Each day at camp we will serve breakfast, lunch, and snacks. If your child has food allergies, please make arrangements to bring in special food if necessary.

This is a camp with intentional programs that run throughout the week; we expect participants to attend all five days (special allowances can be made in advance if needed). We also hope that all participants will take part in the pageant on March 20. (However, children who are ill are encouraged to stay at home to prevent the spread of infection.)
